

Each year, Delta Financial Systems Limited supports a range of programmes and activities in the communities in which we operate and by contributing to charities at both a local and national level. Our aim is to help support organisations which will make a real difference to local communities by having a lasting impact on those who live and work in our local areas.

Delta has a dedicated Fundraising Co-ordinator and each financial year, Delta chooses a charity to sponsor for the year. The Fundraising Coordinator then organises regular events for the benefit of the company's chosen charity.
